# Dress Code

Pupils should be dressed in a professional, business-like way, appropriate to a formal setting. Dress must be safe and not impede the wearer's or others' learning. In the Sixth Form, as for other age groups, the School expects neat appearance and a good standard of dress, both while at school and while travelling to and from school.

- Dark suit (trouser or skirt); dark trousers, traditionally tailored and full length or skirt worn close to the knee, appropriate for a business-like setting with a smart, dark jacket.
- Formal collared shirt, buttoned at the neck with school tie, school colours or prefect's tie; or blouse appropriately buttoned.
- V-neck pullover of single sober colour (if worn, this must be under jacket).
- Natural, grey or black tights.
- Black or brown leather shoes.
- Minimal and discreet make up and jewellery e.g. a single stud in one or both ears.
- Pupils must be clean shaven. Hair should be clean, of a natural colour, and unostentatious in style so that it is safe.

## Trinity - additional clothing is required in the summer term as below

**Cricket** - MCS cricket shirt, cricket sweater, cricket trousers, batting briefs, box, cricket spikes

Cricket kit bags are provided for all teams, so cricket kit can be provided to those boys who are missing certain items. However, once your son gets to a stage where he is playing regularly for teams we recommend the following:

- Bat
- Batting pads
- Batting gloves
- Batting helmet
- Batting thigh guard

**Tennis** - MCS tennis shirt, black shorts (skort or leggings optional for girls), white socks, tennis shoes and at least 1 tennis racquet - possibly more than one in case of a broken string (recommended for all A team players)

**Rowing & Sailing**: The Head of Sport will be in touch with pupils involved in rowing and sailing specifically regarding equipment required

For other sports such as **badminton**, **basketball**, **golf**, **squash**, **pilates**, **climbing**, **gym/HRF** or **cross-country** - students should wear appropriate footwear, MCS Reversible Games shirt, MCS Black Games shorts (leggings or skort) and white socks.

All sports equipment must be kept locked in lockers when not in use. In matters of dispute, the Usher's judgement is final and he reserves the right to send home any pupil who appears at school unsuitably dressed.
